



The exposition was held in both Yokohama and Nagoya, but the types of visitors were different at each venue, and it was a very useful exposition. The Nagoya event in particular led to many high-level technical consultations and requests, and the people working in our booth had to be even more on their toes than usual.

We felt that most of the visitors were from companies located in Aichi Prefecture. This was a satisfactory result because this is the home of many companies involved in the automotive industry. If we can attract more people from further west than Chubu, the exposition might become even more exciting.

This was our first time exhibiting at the exposition, but more people came to our booth than we expected. We had technical discussions with many companies, both large and small, and we hope that the exposition will help to grow our business in the future.

As this was the first in-person event in three years, we were a little apprehensive about how it would go. However, the hall was lively as soon as it started. We had a constructive three days, meeting new people and seeing other familiar faces again.
